

TRA Vaulting Club

ByLaws – Amendment #3

Section Section II of the TRA Vaulting Club ByLaws shall be amended to read:

II

Membership: Parent's or guardians of a child vaulting with the T.R.A. Vaulting Club, or who coaches, or is affiliated with the club in any other manner, and who is a dues paying member of the club in good standing shall be a voting member. Annual dues are \$5 per member paid on the first of October each year.

Effective October 1, 2010, all vaulting families who wish to participate in fundraising (see Section XI) shall have a parent or guardian who is a voting member.

Section Section XI of the TRA Vaulting Club ByLaws shall be amended to read:

XI

Fundraising: T.R.A. Vaulting Club will hold fundraising events to cover costs including but not limited to club costs, first aid supplies, competition supplies, horse transportation costs, and other horse costs for competition, coaches cost, vaulter competition costs, uniforms, vaulting shoes, clinics, vaulting related travel costs, combined team events with other clubs, purchase of equipment, AVA annual dues, AVA Annual Convention costs and other projects approved by the club.


For any reimbursable out-of-pocket vaulter related costs incurred directly by the vaulter (including, but not limited to: uniforms, vaulting shoes, clinics, vaulting travel costs, combined team events with other clubs, purchase of equipment, AVA annual dues, AVA Annual Convention costs and other projects approved by the club) those costs are eligible for but not guaranteed fundraising money. Vaulters seeking reimbursement for out-of-pocket vaulting related costs will need to submit a Reimbursement Request Form for Use of Horsebucks to the Treasurer with supporting receipts and reimbursement is limited to actual costs incurred.

If the vaulter quits or is asked to leave The Riding Academy or the Club, all moneys raised by that vaulter will revert to the Club's general fund after 30 days, during which time the vaulter can submit a Horsebucks Reimbursement Form to request reimbursement for vaulting related costs. If a vaulter obtains the approval of the Director to temporarily stop vaulting, all moneys raised by that vaulter will remain on hold in that vaulter's name. The vaulter is required to inform the Director of his/her intention to return to vaulting. If the vaulter has not returned to vaulting within 6 months. all moneys raised by that vaulter will revert to the Club's general fund.


Certification of Adoption of ByLaws – Amendment #3


